Police 2 Citizen (P2C) Online Program Launch

The Warner Robins Police Department along with the Houston County Sheriff's Department and Centerville Police Department announce the launch of the new online program Police 2 Citizen (P2C).

P2C allows citizens to view and map police incidents, search for specific events, and obtain accident reports. Citizens can also see Wanted and Missing Persons as well as a daily bulletin of the day's events. Accident reports can be obtained through this service free of charge. Pertinent information must be provided to access accident reports.

The Warner Robins Police Department and the Houston County Sheriff's Office submitted a joint application for the FY2008 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program. The two jurisdictions used the grant money (valued at \$11,962) toward the purchase of the P2C and Quartermaster module for the local Records Management System. The total cost for the two modules totaled \$21,150. The Warner Robins Police Department and the Houston County Sheriff's Office each paid \$4,594 to cover the remaining balance after the JAG grant was applied.

This service is free to the public.
